"Chun éileamh ar tuaraisc ag léiriú cé mhéid atá chomhairle chontae chorcaí tar éis caitheamh ar dumpáil mídhleathach gach bhliain ó 2011, an bhfuil méadú tagtha ar an méid dumpáil mídhleathach atá ag tarlú, agus má tá, an féidir cúis a thabhairt don méadú sin.

To ask for a report illustrating how much Cork County Council has spent on illegal dumping every year from 2011, if there is an increase in illegal dumping in that period, and if so, if it is possible to give any reasons for such an increase."

Report:

The Environment Directorates expenditure on illegal dumping, excluding salaries and wages and other directorate expenditure, was:-

€145,925.12	€150,998.48	€151,326.99	€448,250.59

The number of incidents reported to the council's anti-litter phone line and email were of the order of 1800-2000 a year for the last number of years, it is 787 to date in 2015 which would indicate the same level on incidents in 2015.
