Response from Ken O'Riordan, Non National Road Design Office:

L2472 Coach Hill, Rochestown - Progress Note – July 2016:

The Cork County Council Road Design office have completed a topographical survey of the Coach Hill study area and have developed a preliminary design for the introduction of a footpath along the full length of Coach Hill.

The preliminary design scheme has been discussed internally with the Carrigaline Area Office Engineers and the CCC Traffic Department.

CCC Road Design Engineers have had a preliminary discussion onsite with a landowner impacted by the proposal in July 2016. A number of actions came out of this meeting and these will be addressed by both parties during the summer. Based on the outcome of the meeting and the actions, the design will be revised.

Please note there is no funding in place at this time for this road improvement project. We expect that we will have a draft preliminary design for consideration in early Q4 of the present year.
