

## **CORK COUNTY COUNCIL**

### **CASUAL TRADING BYE LAWS**

Cork County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 6 of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, Local Government Act 2001 and Part 1 of Schedule 14A of the Local Government Reform Act 2014, intends to make bye-laws in relation to the control, regulation, supervision and administration of Casual Trading within its functional area. These Bye Laws propose to provide for the imposition of a fixed payment under Section 206 of Local Government Act 2001.
