Notice under Section 179 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)

In accordance with the requirements of Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001 (as amended) notice is hereby given that Cork County Council proposes to carry out the following development:

Development of a Pedestrian and Cycle Greenway and Ancillary Works

The proposed Pedestrian and Cycle Greenway extends from the entrance to the Cross River Ferry terminal at Glenbrook to Raffeen Bridge, Raffeen within the townlands of Lackaroe, Monkstown, Monkstown (Castle Farm), Ballyfouloo, Raffeen and Shanbally, Co. Cork.

The proposal consists of the Development of a Pedestrian and Cycle Greenway (approximately 4.6km in length) incorporating the following elements:

- Provision of a bound macadam pathway between 3.0m and 4.0m wide
- Provision of 2 no. boardwalk structures
- Provision of a new car park at Strawhall
- Provision of traffic calming at Raffeen
- Provision of public lighting on sections of the scheme
- Provision of fencing and railings
- Provision of signage, markings and delineation works, landscaping, ancillary drainage and all associated development works.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development shall be available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy during normal office hours on each day during which the said offices are open for the transaction of business during the period commencing on Friday July 8th 2016 and ending on Friday August 19th 2016, both dates inclusive, at the following offices of Cork County Council:

- Carrigaline Area Office, Church Road, Carrigaline, Co. Cork.
