

**Ballincollig Carrigaline Municipal District Meeting on
18th February 2019**

To: Chairperson and Each Member of the Municipal District

I refer to the following Notice of Motion from which is on the Agenda for the meeting of the Municipal District on the 18th February 2019.

Cllr D'Alton & Cllr McGrath:

That representatives of the Port of Cork would meet with the members of this Municipal District to discuss with them their plans for Marino Point.

Report:

A similar motion to the above was passed by the Cobh Municipal District in December 2018 and a letter issued to the Port of Cork requesting that they meet with the Members of that District.

The Evening Echo ran a report on 18th December 2018, quoting the Port of Cork Chairman advising that the Port of Cork are working on a Masterplan for the site which they will be presenting to Cork County Council. Given that the hope to have tenants in place in 2019/2020 one would expect that this Masterplan should be available sooner rather than later.

Given that Marino point is situated in the Cobh Municipal District that would, to my mind, appear to be the most appropriate Municipal District meeting for the Port of Cork to attend. Members could ask Cobh MD to facilitate their attendance at any meeting that the Port of Cork will have with them as opposed to requesting a separate meeting.
