Notice is hereby given that Cork County Council proposes to carry out the following development:-

Upgrade and signalisation of the roundabout junction of the South Douglas Road, N40 off ramp West Douglas and Willow Park Road

Location:

South Douglas Road (R-851), Douglas, Cork City

Nature and extent of proposed development:

The main physical elements of the proposal are:

- Removal of the existing roundabout
- Installation of traffic signals on four approach roads
- Revised layout of road into Willow Park and Gaelscoil Na Doughlaise, incorporating signalisation.
- Revised layout of lanes and the end of N40 off ramp
- Improved pedestrian facilities with extension of footpaths and construction of a traffic island
- Coordination with signals at West Douglas/N40 On Ramp junction
